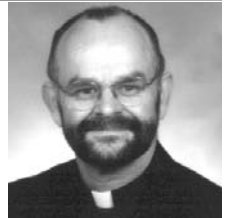

Let's Make "OUR HOUSE" a Home

The OUR HOUSE Team has stepped up to complete another much needed project in the church building. The team led by **Jarrowslav** enclosed a space discovered behind a sealed off wall in the Sunday school bathroom. This room was a former coal chute which has a radiator and a blocked up window. A dividing wall with a door was installed including some finishing plaster work to make the space more useful and more pleasant for the very young members of the congregation and their teachers to use.

A more permanent space is being created for the OUR HOUSE Team and some of the equipment it requires to make your church a safer and more welcoming space to worship. Storage shelves and room to work on specific projects is now being developed. Once completed the team will have a safe place to organise and store its equipment. If you are replacing a piece of woodworking machinery, plaster equipment or electrical tools and would like to offer them to the team please contact OUR HOUSE team leader **Roy Dean** (see contact information listed below) to make arrangements. Only fully operational and complete equipment is requested.

Room #210 has been transformed and its conversion to a tech workshop has begun. **Bruce Davidson**, our tech team leader has begun installing and organising the computer equipment to better serve the churches internal computer needs. The room also offers space for a small staff kitchen.

The kitchen has suffered some water damage to its west wall over the winter; it is reassuring to know that this damage was caused by a leaking radiator on the second floor. This occurred when the boiler was having repair work done to it. It will be attended to shortly when the finishing details will be completed.

THRIFT SHOP

The MCC Toronto Thrift shop is located on the balcony of the Social Hall is open Sundays between 10:00am and 1:00pm.

All proceeds from the donated merchandise go to support Metropolitan Community Church of Toronto. During January, 2008, the Thrift Shop was able to contribute \$643.00 from sales (\$160.75 per week) to the Church. January is traditionally a slow month. This exceeds the \$541.00 that was contributed in January, 2007. Our FASHION CLEARANCE continues on the west side of the balcony. Jeans, shorts, and casual unisex pants (sweat and wind pants) are priced at \$2.00 a pair. Dress pants, dresses and skirts are \$5.00. T-shirts, short sleeve shirts and blouses, vests, hats, gloves, scarves, shoulder bags, and belts are \$2.00. All styles of sweaters, long sleeve shirts, sport jackets, and shoes/ boots are priced at \$5.00. Men's suits and spring weight outerwear sell for \$10.00. Winter-weight coats and jackets cost \$20.00. Ties and socks are \$1.00. We currently have a good punch bowl set, a bread making machine, and several nice table lamps in stock. Weekday donations should be carried up to the top of the stairs to the left of the stage in the Social Hall and deposited behind the green velvet curtains. Donate stocks/securities to the church and cut down on your income tax!

A gift of publicly traded securities can help you make a significant contribution to MCC Toronto at a relatively low cost to you. Changes in the 2006 federal budget mean that by making a gift of securities to the church, your taxable capital gain is eliminated.

For example, the privatization of BCE Inc., Canada's most widely held stock, in 2008 means that shareholders will be required to sell their shares. If you hold BCE shares, you can eliminate some or all capital gain taxes on this buyout by donating those shares-in-kind to MCC Toronto prior to the buyout.

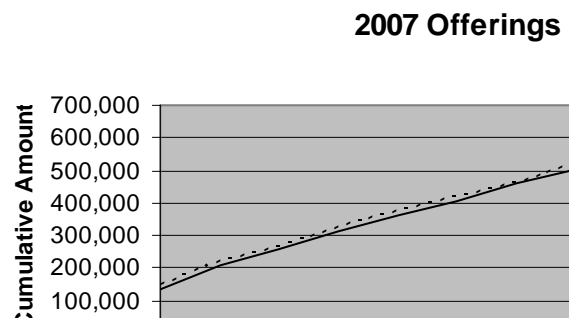

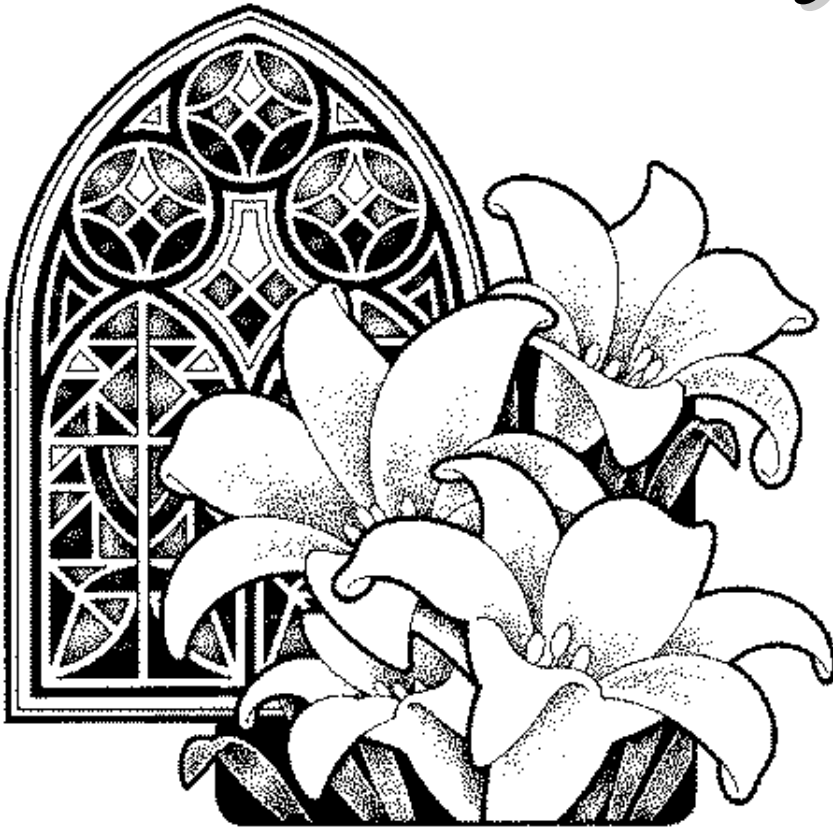

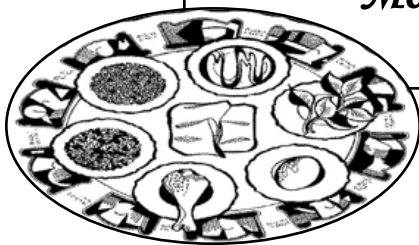
