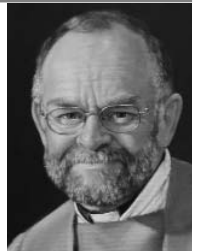

BILLY NEWTON-DAVIS

International singing superstar, Billy Newton-Davis, has been one of Canada's premier entertainers for over 25 years. His roots were firmly planted at the age of 5 at a Baptist church in his hometown of Cleveland, Ohio where he learned to sing gospel music. His debut album, *Love Is a Contact Sport* included the songs 'Deeper,' 'Right Beside You,' and 'Find My Way Back,' and won Billy Newton-Davis the 1986 Juno award for best R&B/Soul recording and most promising male vocalist. His 1989 follow-up, *Spellbound*, included his most successful single 'I Can't Take It,' as well as 'Can't Live with You' (a duet with Celine Dion), and won the 1989 Juno award as best R&B/Soul recording.

In 1991, Billy joined **The Nylons** and enjoyed a successful stretch performing and touring with the world-renowned singing group. Since leaving The Nylons, he has primarily concentrated on song writing and live jazz and gospel performances. Billy also appeared as guest vocalist on the 'Seekers Dialogue' series with internationally acclaimed author and lecturer Marianne Williamson.

Hot Off The Press! Billy Newton-Davis vs. Deadmau5, just recently won the Juno Award for "Best Dance Recording 2007" for the track "All You Ever Want" He recently headlined the Casey House Event "**SnowBall 2008/Passion**" at the Royal York Hotel and following that he made an appearance with "The Nylons" in Madison, Wisconsin, for an evening to celebrate their latest recording "**Sterling**". Yes Billy is definitely on fire, and back in the studio recording new tracks!

Billy will be performing on June 2 at the "One More Song" Choir Concert celebrating 35 years of music at MCC Toronto.

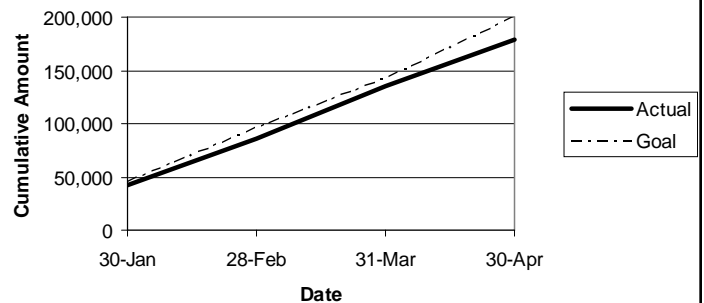
