Christmas Eve Services



While all of us are watching the rise of COVID-19 case numbers with concern, MCC Toronto wants to reassure you that we are doing - and will do - everything in our power to make our Christmas Eve Services safe for all. We will be rigorously inspecting vaccine passports or proof of vaccination for those over 12 years of age, and single vaccinations for those 5-12 years of age, at the door and will require mandatory masking throughout the service. And while the government of Ontario's recent directive that large scale gatherings be limited to 50% capacity (as of December 18), our plans were always based on no more than a 38% capacity with a limit of 230 attendees including congregants, choir, and volunteers per Service. We are also redoing the seating plan to encourage better social distancing. 

Announcing our 2021 Community Outreach Partnership (COP) Grant Recipients



Thanks to the support of donors to our monthly 10-10-10 Giving Program, MCC Toronto is thrilled to announce this year's recipients of our Community Outreach Partnership (COP) Grant.

A \$5,000 grant was awarded to Act-On Ability Foundation, a new start-up charitable initiative dedicated to providing an employment platform for persons with disabilities who typically are not accommodated when it comes to training to work within film, television and theatre. John Stevens, a Board member of the Act-On Ability Foundation, was on-hand at our December 12, 11 AM Worship Service to speak about the important work they are doing.



A \$500 grant was also awarded to The Ecumenical Chaplaincy at the University of Toronto to support programming for queer students of faith at U of T.

MCC Toronto's Community Outreach Partnership (COP) Grant serves to support underfunded community organizations that are doing important work in the areas of LGBTQ2S+, human rights, health and/or social services that are aligned with our vision and mission. Since 2004, over \$155,000 has been granted through the COP program to 37 community organizations.




