We'll continue with a hybrid approach of online and in-person worship services with **Digital Coffee hour at a new time of 1 PM**. For the time being, we will continue to ask folks (aged 5 and up) attending in-person Worship Services to bring their vaccine passport or proof of double vaccination. While the Ontario government lifted its proof of vaccination requirements effective March 1, MCC Toronto will continue them at least until our congregants are comfortable and as per **City of Toronto guidelines** "faith-based organizations have an opportunity to implement a vaccine protocol for community members to attend in-person services and other activities."


