Dear MCC Toronto Friends & Faithful,

Like many of you, we at MCC Toronto are horrified by the human rights violations we are seeing in Ukraine. We stand in solidarity with the Ukrainian people, those in Russia and Belarus advocating for peace, and we join the global community in condemning these acts of war.

This Putin-led attack on Ukraine is also an attack on LGBTQ+ rights and freedoms as part of the Russian government's far-right, anti-gay agenda. This past week the **patriarch of the Russian Orthodox Church suggested** that Pride parades were the litmus test for liberal western morality that need to be stomped out with Russia's invasion of Ukraine. We fear for our queer siblings who face the loss of decades of work towards inclusion, along with the very real loss of life.

As part of the Dignity Network, a Canadian-based coalition of civil society organizations

working on international SOGIE (Sexual Orientation Gender Identity and Expression) rights, we at MCC Toronto are working to understand the impacts of this invasion on Ukraine's leading LGBTQ+ organizations and taking action to support them. Through our LGBTQ+ Refugee Programs, we will soon be launching an information awareness campaign to let Ukrainian community organizations and refugee-serving agencies across Canada that we are here to help LGBTQ+ Ukrainians. We stand ready to provide support and services to LGBTQ+ Ukraine refugees who are trying to get to Canada and to those who are trying to get to Canada.


