Palms, or pussy willows? Palms don't have a lot of relevance in Canadian culture, because palm trees don't grow here. But every year, Rev. Jeff waves pussy willows with his palm fronds, because pussy willows DO grow in Canada, AND they are some of the first harbingers of Spring.

Rev. Jeff is in good company. In many Orthodox churches, particularly in both Ukraine and Russia, the Palm Sunday tradition is to wave pussy willows, and to keep them with the icons in their house until the next Palm Sunday. There is a legend that it is the pussy willow that tells all the other plants that it is time to wake up and grow again. Their arrival was also a sign that the long days of the Lenten Fast were coming to an end.

We, too, celebrate the coming of Spring. But on Palm Sunday we also celebrate with Christians around the world, including both Ukraine and Russia, the coming of Jesus the Christ into ancient Jerusalem. Let us be united with them in our hopes and dreams of peace in this season.


The great festival of Holy Week and Easter are upon us.

Cantor David Rosen is our Offertory Performer this Sunday!

Cantor Rosen is senior cantor and music director at Toronto's Holy Blossom Temple.

He is a sought-after performer of Jewish and secular music, and has performed in concerts across the United States, Canada, and Europe. His rich, versatile baritone voice has allowed him to sing a wide repertoire of music, from traditional Chazzanut to Broadway showtunes.

He recently produced and was a soloist in "Gifts of Light," an interfaith virtual concert to raise money for the United Way's COVID Relief Fund. The event attracted thousands of virtual viewers and included stars such as Steven Page, Richard Margison, and musicians from the Toronto Symphony Orchestra.

Cantor Rosen serves as adjunct faculty at the Debbie Friedman School of Sacred Music at Hebrew Union College – Jewish Institute of Religion. He is a member of the Cantors' Assembly, a past president of the Toronto Council of Hazzanim, and a member of the executive board of the American Conference of Cantors, where he sits on the ethics committee and the admissions panel.

In 2021, Cantor Rosen launched the Holy Blossom Centre for Arts and Culture, a multidisciplinary centre attracting performers and educators from around the globe who perform and teach at Holy Blossom Temple, serving both its membership and the community at large.


