Congregational Campaign Matching Gift Opportunity



Since the launch of our Congregational Campaign, we have been incredibly heartened by the early and enthusiastic response. In less than two weeks, we have raised \$32,500 towards our \$150,000 goal!

Of course, thanks to Anne Brayley & Nanette Sanson and Andrew Fleming & Roger Keglevich, we have actually raised \$65,000. These long-time congregants (and good friends) have come together agreed to match every donation – dollar for dollar – up to \$75,000 in support of our Congregational Campaign. Thanks to their generosity, and that of early contributors, we now stand at 43% of our goal, bringing us closer to the beautification of our beloved Sanctuary. As announced on April 24, funds raised through the Congregational Campaign within the **ELEVATION Campaign** will be earmarked for much needed

renovations to our Sanctuary including wall and ceiling repairs, painting and the replacement of main floor carpets.

If over \$150,000 is raised, MCC Toronto will look to repair and replace all exterior doors, improve air circulation features and make the chancel space accessible. Work on Sanctuary space improvements will begin in the summer of 2023.




