Updates on our LGBTQ+ Refugee Programs



This Monday (June 20) is **World Refugee Day**. As MCC Toronto is Canada's only LGBTQ+ exclusive Sponsorship Agreement Holder with the federal government, this day is especially important to us. For the past 15 years, our LGBTQ+ Refugee Programs have been working extremely hard, bringing many people from terribly dangerous environments to safety. So far,

we have been able to support over **74** brave LGBTQ+ folks escape from torture or death sentence.

Just this past month, we've welcomed 7 LGBTQ+ individuals from Iran, Syria, and Venezuela. But that would not have been possible without the incredible efforts of our wonderful sponsorship teams that took on the important responsibility of saving lives. The teams greeted their sponsored refugees at the airport and gave them a warm welcome. You can do the same and join us this Sunday, on June 19, during our Worship Service. It's for great moments like these that we understand and appreciate how increasingly vital our human rights work is becoming, every day.

Particularly with the urgent humanitarian crisis in Afghanistan and Ukraine, we have doubled our efforts in raising awareness and providing support to LGBTQ+ Afghans and Ukrainians. For instance, we've given a number of interviews including **The Globe and Mail**, **The Toronto Star**, and **Radio-Canada**; did a social media collaboration with Canadian-Ukrainian activist and actor, **Andrew Kushnir**; and are in the process of hiring a Human Rights Director thanks to our **Elevation Campaign**.

We are also happy to celebrate the formation of Team Safe Haven, a new sponsorship team that has come together to help settle 2 of the 50 LGBTQ+ Afghan refugees who have registered with us. The members of Team Safe Haven will be co-hosts of MCC Toronto's Community Booth as part of **Pride's Street Fair**. You can visit their fundraising page here.

Mask Mandate Survey Results




Many thanks to the 194 congregants who responded to our Mask Mandate Survey. Your feedback was tremendously important to us as we considered whether to maintain or lift

MCC Toronto's current mask mandate.

Making our task more difficult is that our congregants are evenly split on the mask mandate question – 50% of respondents prefer to maintain the mask mandate while 50% would prefer mask wearing to be optional. Digging into the results further, the following stat gave us pause:

How might making masks optional impact your attendance in person at MCC Toronto?



It would not change my likeliness to attend
 It would make me less likely to attend
 It would make me more likely to attend
 It would make me neither more or less likely to attend

This question was posed to folks who have attended at least one in-person since March 2022. With 31% saying that the making masks optional would make them less likely to attend, and only 23% saying it would make them more likely to attend, we have decided to maintain the mask mandate – at least for the next while. Please know that we are grateful for the PAGES and PAGES of comments that folks provided along with their survey answers – we've read them all and appreciate the extra effort you took to offer your feedback on this important issue.

MCC Toronto hopes and prays that our members and congregants will continue to be patient with us as we work to ensure the health and safety of the more vulnerable around us.


