Building Fund Phase 2 Progress

For those who haven't been to MCC Toronto in the past month – there have been some changes!

Since our Building Fund Phase 2 Project officially began on June 6, the construction team – led by our own Mark Asselin and Santiago Arias - has completed the following work:

- Removal of Floor from the meeting rooms, through the corridors, and the Social Hall
- Demolition of Walls & Ceilings the former Rooms 109 111, the vestibule, the Information Desk, the former Facility Manager's Office, the former Welcome Room 100, have now been entirely demolished
- Demolition of Social Hall Stage the stage and stairs have been removed
- Mechanical & Electrical initial roughing in has begun

Please note that the **ramped entrance** and **elevator** are still accessible to folks who need extra assistance when attending our Services.


Celebrating a Retired (But Never Retiring) Board Member


