When I joined MCC Toronto's clergy team last year, I didn't just find a new church home – I became a part of a new, worldwide denomination of churches – the Universal Fellowship of Metropolitan Community Churches (UFMCC).

Making a home in the UFMCC means pursuing ordination within the UFMCC. I was ordained back in 2007, so I'm not exactly seeking to be re-ordained. But I am working to make my ordination official within the MCC world.

What does that look like? I'm glad you asked!

This weekend, it looks like a 3-day retreat called REVM. REVM stands for Readiness to Enter Vocational Ministry, and it's UFMCC's official intake program for folks who are new to MCC ministry.

At the REVM retreat, folks like me will learn more about what makes MCC special. We'll grow our understanding of MCC's work around intersectionality, anti-racism, anti-oppression, and anti-colonialism, and how we can be a part of that work. We'll explore the ways MCC integrates spiritualty, sexuality, and overall wellness. And we'll make important connections, both with retreat leaders and our fellow participants.

I'm excited for this next step in my ministry, and I can't wait to celebrate with my MCC Toronto family when I become "UFMCC Official."

As you pray in the days to come, I hope you'll say a prayer for me as I embark on this part of my vocational journey. And I hope you'll say a prayer of gratitude for the wider family of MCC communities around the world.


