Mark conceived Pride & Joy, a small chamber choir, as part of MCC Toronto's legendary DNA Project, a from-the-ground-up engagement process that led to the establishment of MCC's bedrock beliefs in 2002. His vision was to bring together a group of singers (most drawn from The Choir of MCC Toronto) who could bring joyful and healing music beyond the walls of MCC Toronto. Twenty-years later, Mark and his merry band of talented singers have succeeded!

Since their first public performance at a memorial at The 519 in October 2002, Pride & Joy have been mainstays at weddings, funerals, birthdays and anniversaries. They have performed at many churches in and around Toronto, as well as other special public events. Diane Leah, MCC Toronto's former Music Director, was instrumental in helping the group over the years through coaching and song arranging, as was Eric Johnson who served as Artistic Director up until his move to New Brunswick last year. At this Sunday's Worship Service, Pride & Joy will be performing *Happy Together*, a song that couldn't be more apt for a group that has been there for each other every step of the way.

MCC Toronto moves to Optional Mask Mandate

IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT!

Two Fridays ago we asked our members and congregants to participate in a Survey and provide us with their thoughts on MCC Toronto's current mandatory mask mandate at our Worship Services. And you responded – with 66% of our members and congregants urging us to move to an optional mask mandate immediately.

In response and beginning at this Sunday's (Oct 16) 11 AM Worship Service, MCC Toronto will be moving to a STRONGLY RECOMMENDED but OPTIONAL mask mandate, which will put us in line with almost all other city-wide agencies and organizations, from the TTC, to public libraries, to government offices, to other church denominations.

As the safety of our congregants, volunteers and staff at our Services is of paramount concern to all of us, we will:

- Strongly encourage all attendees to our Services to wear a mask, which we will be happy to provide if needed; we also have a stock of face shields
- Encourage folks who cough or sneeze to wear a mask or to watch the Service from home
- Post screening posters at all entrances
- Ask attendees to use hand sanitizer use upon entry
- Keep windows open and fans working

We thank all the members and congregants who responded to our Survey and apologize for any inconveniences caused by this decision. We will, of course, be monitoring the situation on a weekly basis going forward and I promise you we will move to re-instate a mandatory mask mandate if necessary.


