At our December 18 Sunday Worship Service, we were delighted to present this year's Community Outreach Partnerships (COP) grant of \$5,000 to Transforming Style.

Transforming Style is a new Toronto-based start-up organization that provides cost-free support, beauty & styling services, and wardrobe to 2SLGBTQIA+ community members who face barriers to access. You can read more about their amazing work here.

With Transforming Style, our adjudicators (made up of members of our Engagement Committee of the MCC Toronto Board) saw great alignment with MCC Toronto's work and mission, and an organization that was addressing important issues around equality and accessibility.

COP grants are awarded annual and are intended as an opportunity to expand MCC Toronto's reach into the community. Since the late 90s, MCC Toronto has granted over \$150,000 to over 40 community organizations

If you are able, we would be grateful for your support. With your help, the best is yet to come!




