

Celebrating the Reopening of our Spaces



Mark your calendar!

Following our Sunday Service on **February 19**, MCC Toronto invites you to join us as we celebrate the reopening of our now named McCain Family Social Hall. Per Rev. Deana's

suggestion, we are calling the event Let the Light Shine In!

After eight long months of construction, we can finally return to using all the 5,000 net square foot spaces that have been lovingly and beautifully renovated. Exciting new features include:

- A newly light-filled renovated Social Hall due to the removal of the drop ceiling and the unveiling of clerestory windows along three walls that have been boarded up for 30+ years!
- The creation of a new Programming Wing comprised of the former rooms 109, 110 and 111; these fresh new spaces will soon bear the names – Rainbow Room, Lavender Room, and Butterfly Room – and will be for congregational & internal programming and community use!
- A new totally accessible Information Desk is now positioned next to our elevator!
- A new Welcome Centre (former Room 100) will take over the space currently occupied by our facilities team!
- A new, fully equipped Altar Guild suite (former Room 100)!

We can't wait to begin to move into our new spaces! Looking ahead ...

- On February 22, we will host our first Community Meal in the Social Hall at 6 PM in celebration of Mardi Gras, to be followed by an Ash Wednesday Service in the Sanctuary at 7:30 PM!
- Beginning later this month, our LGBTQ+ Refugee Team will move its in-person Orientation and Information Sessions back into our Social Hall and Programming Wing!
- Beginning this spring and summer, our new Human Rights team will begin rolling out new public and partner programming, including launching a new initiative that will mentor, house, provide funding and offer operational support for queer youth-led advocacy groups in Toronto!

As always, many, many thanks to donors to our **ELEVATION – MCC Toronto Campaign**, whose support have made these renovations possible. Very special thanks to our Facility Team of Mark and Santiago for overseeing this huge undertaking.



Black History Spotlight

We continue to celebrate Black History Month with fantastic music by black artists, insightful Lessons for Life, and spotlighting influential black figures in our history. Last week, Rev. This Sunday, Rev. Junia will be sharing the story of Viola Desmond. Desmond was a businesswoman who fought against racial discrimination in Canada in the late 1940s. A person of faith, Desmond's activism drew inspiration from her church, Halifax's Cornwallis Street Baptist, and her pastor, Rev. Dr. Willam Pearly Oliver. Desmond's story is a vital piece of Canadian history; it's also a reminder that faith and human rights activism have a rich history of going hand in hand.




