It is with mixed sadness and profound gratitude that I tell you that our beloved Facilities Manager, Mark J. "Oak" Asselin, died Wednesday morning at Casey House. It was very, very peaceful, and he was surrounded by loving family and friends. I can also tell you that Mark was more than ready in so many ways – to leave the pain of his illness behind and start the new adventure of what lies beyond this earthly life.

I acknowledge that the concept of Medical Assistance in Dying is a difficult subject for many people. I confess that when Canada first began the conversations about making M.A.I.D. an accessible choice, I had trouble with it. But the older I get, and the more needless suffering I see, I have come around to understanding that death with dignity can be a human right. Mark wanted to be very open about his choice, and whatever our feelings are about M.A.I.D., I hope we can all completely respect his autonomy around his own life and death.

Mainly at this time, I want to express my profound gratitude for Mark, and the gifts – both personal and professional – that he has given us, and gratitude to all of the folks who have helped make Mark's last days so peaceful and happy; in particular, I want to thank Brendalee Cox and Tanisha Roberts for giving Mark a home in his last months – a true example of faithful hospitality. I also hope you will pray for those who mourn Mark, especially his family, friends, and colleagues here at MCC Toronto.


