


This is only a small step for us to take, and it is probably long overdue. As a faith community we need to be constantly mindful of our obligations and opportunities to be

Due to the increased demand for this activity in support of our cherished LGBTQ+ refugee program participants, we have decided to integrate the taking of photographs into our LGBTQ+ Refugee Program activities where our program participants gather.

Starting November 20, our refugee photography sessions will be integrated into the twice-monthly LGBTQ+ Refugee Program Orientation sessions, beginning at 1:30 PM. Participation will be limited to individuals with advanced registration and detailed registration information will be provided in an upcoming newsletter from the LGBTQ+ Refugee Programs.

We believe this move will ensure a less busy and more amiable Social Hour & Cookie Situation while also providing better access and opportunity to our program participants looking for photographs with the Worship Team in support of their refugee claimant cases.


